Addendum number 1 is issued for Questions

**The Closing Date for this RFP has not changed.
Proposals will be received until Tuesday January 4, 2022 @ 3:00 PM Alaska time.**

Questions:

1. The RFP states gas cards will be issued for Anchorage and Fairbanks. Will there be a gas card for the Whittier location or at a pass-through cost?
The ARRC will issue gas cards for Anchorage and Fairbanks because those vehicles are used by the full-time security officer and dedicated to the ARRC contract. The ARRC won't issue a gas card for the Whittier location because that vehicle is used part-time and may be driven back to Anchorage which allows the contractor to use it on other contracts or purposes.
2. Are electronic signatures accepted for the forms? For the notarized form?
Yes for both forms this will be accepted at the current time.
3. Will ARRC provide vehicle for unscheduled Port Security at Seward?
The ARRC does not have any spare vehicles, and we are unable to provide one for unscheduled Port Security events in Seward. The other issue is liability, the ARRC requires the contractor to use their own vehicles, and not ARRC vehicles.
4. Will ARRC provide vehicle for out of scope, unscheduled security?
The ARRC does not have any spare vehicles for contract security officers to use, and as previously mentioned there would be liability issues.
5. Will additional vehicles be required during summer hours in Fairbanks and Anchorage?
There are no overlapping security shifts in Anchorage or Fairbanks, officers use the one assigned vehicle in Anchorage and the one assigned vehicle in Fairbanks, thus, no additional vehicles will be required.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
